I've had to fight a few times, but nothing that ended bad for me. Once you are well established in a prison and you've earned the respect of the "solid" convicts (~~meaning non-sexoffenders~~ who are straight and have never switched on anyone) people are less likley to do anything disrespectful to you. Because if they do, they will be "dealt with" by ALL of the solids. This can mean anything from a scolding by some leaders, to being stabbed to death in the shower.

A. Obviously this person is not from America. I think I'll commit my next imaginary crime in Norway. It sounds nice over there.

Q. "Can I send your son some vitamins? He looks like he needs vitamins. His eyes have circles around them."

A. By all means, send my boy some Flintstones. But if those circles around his eyes turn into squirts, switch to some other vitamins. I might need some vitamins myself. It's going on 7 years and I could use some vitamin foods. You can't get that in here.

The worst of the worst muslims are sunis from Saudi Arabia. If you're a Saudi woman, you're not allowed to have an education, a drivers license, or a clitoris. I'm not joking. I've been on phone and email restriction for the last 60 days and unable to hear from people like usual. But when a dollar amount and a last name shows up on my account it's like getting a message in a bottle.

This morning I logged on to the computer and saw a check from Kahn for \$100, "No Name" for \$107, one for \$30, "Triemet" for \$200, "owen" for \$30, and "Harrison" for \$100. My friend was sitting next to me looking over my shoulder. He put his hand on my shoulder and said "Hmmm, You're really loved by a lot of people." He is right. I'm in what is arguably the worst prison on the planet right now, and yet I'm so blessed. I see all of you out there, and it makes my heart feel warm. Good is outshining evil. All will be well.
