- Life pump must be rated at least 1 hp. The Gould WE1012H and Little Giant 513520 230-volt pumps are examples of equipment meeting this standard.
- You must obtain a permit from Panhandle Health will require a letter of permission to hook up to the CBCS systems before they will issue a permit. The permission letter may be obtained by contacting the CBCS bookkeeper at 208-686-7106 Home or 208-686-5161 Office.
- Property owners must acknowledge receipt of this information and agreement, including information listed on the reverse of this page, in writing. A copy of this letter will be retained in the CBCS files and the original letter will be provided to the property owner.
