Notability

- In your "iPad Work" folder, create a new note called "My Summer Journal"
- Take lots of pictures of the different things you do and add the pictures to your journal with a brief written description
- If you forget to take pictures (or don't have the opportunity to) while you are out, try using some Google Images instead
- Import a calendar for each month of the summer and fill it out with all of your activities and schedule.

Scanning App

- Scan brochures from places you go and then write about what your favourite thing was about it in Notability
- Scan tickets from movies or other shows you go to see
- See if you can get Prizmo to read a menu to you

Brainstorming/Mind Mapping Tool

- Create a diagram of your packing list for camp or for a vacation in Inspiration and then send the diagram to your journal from Inspiration to Notability
- Check off your, items in Notability, as you pack them


