Hi,

Let it be known, that I, state your name, affirm to defend the Second Amendment. I shall support and assist any American Gun Owner, who is subjected to any type of enforcement whatsoever pertaining to firearms registration or confiscation; and to resist any such unlawful and treasonous actions by whomever. Private ownership of firearms are the foundation of freedom, without such, freedom is lost. I shall defend freedom and liberty at all costs; to this I pledge my honor, my fortune, and my life.

Make no mistake about it, our enemy is moving in for the kill. Our enemy is highly intelligent, extremely rich, and is rolling over this planet like a tsunami. Our dilemma is that a majority of Americans are stupid. The enemy's is so enormous in scope and well organized, that the average American cannot wrap his mind around the enemy's conspiracy for world domination. The upper echelon of this conspiracy is well hidden, like the roots of a tree. The roots give the tree its support and sustenance and determine the tree's size and strength. We may not be able to get at these subterranean culprits, but we do know what they are using to enslave us — governments and fiat currency — which should be considered the trunk of the tree in our metaphoric analogy.

Our enemy is ruthless. Sometime in the 1990s a man killed a bunch of children at a school in Scotland; within weeks the United Kingdom proscribed all private ownership of firearms and confiscated all the firearms. Hmmm Sound familiar. The same exact scenario

is being played out here, now, in America. In Australia, around the same time as Scotland, a guy shot a bunch of people in a beach with an AK-47. Shortly thereafter all firearms were banned and confiscated. This is our enemy's goal here too. The second amendment means nothing. It is only words on paper. What means something, are men + women willing to take a stand and not back down, to give meaning to the second amendment. Without such brave patriots the second amendment is worth only the paper it is written on.

I want to speak frankly and candid to my reader, but I cannot due to my circumstances. I will give another metaphoric explanation to the situation we are faced with. Think the American People as the wildebeest, zebras, gazelles, water buffaloes, and all the other grazing animals. There are millions of them as compared to just a few thousand of ruthless lions. The lions stalk their prey, killing at pleasure, and taking its sustenance from the herds, as they sleep all day without worry of being attacked. If the herds of beast simply united, they could destroy their enemy, the ruthless lions. Nature has not given these herds the reasoning to figure this out and the lions have nothing to fear in this regard.

I have said over and over, the key to our victory is unity encompassed with courage. The founding generation had these attributes; and until we get them, we are not going to be able to defend liberty. The Republican party was founded on the platform of emancipating the African slaves; our policy is to emancipate ourselves, but more importantly, to emancipate our posterity. I think of our venerable ancestors who laid down their lives for

you, me and the individual screening this correspondence. Whether this individual realizes it or not, we are concerned about his liberty too; and this individual should also be concerned. One such venerable patriot was the physician Joseph Warren. When Massachusetts broke from the Crown, they set up their own representative body and called it the provincial congress. The first three were held from 1774-75, and Warren was a member of all three and president of the third. He helped establish the network of public safety committees, where people would get together plan, assist and carry out acts of resistance to the Crown's government. When Boston was occupied by Crown forces, Warren stayed in Boston, spying on the British. Dr. Warren learned the enemy had put into action their plan to go into the countryside to seize the terrorists Samuel Adams and John Hancock and to seize the muskets, cannon, shot and powder stored at the magazine in Concord. This was the evening of April 18, 1775, a Tuesday. Dr. Warren had Paul Revere and William Dawes summoned to his house in north Boston, and sent them on their famous ride. Dawes went to the countryside via the land bridge that connected Boston to the mainland known as the "neck." While Revere rowed across the Charles River to Charlestown where another patriot loaned him a fresh horse. Dawes + Revere met up outside Lexington, where Revere was captured by the British as Dawes escaped while being shot at. Dawes went on to warn Concord. Together Dawes and Revere warned Adams and Hancock who were staying at the Parson's house just off the Lexington commons. Hancock wanted to stay and fight with Captain Parkers' militia who were assembling on the commons, but Adams and Revere convinced him to flee instead, because they were needed at the Continental Congress in two weeks.

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Paul Revere managed to escape from the enemy as he was being sent to the back of the enemy's lines. Shortly thereafter the British confronted Captain Parkers' 39 men, made up of boys, men and old men, mostly farmers, who made the most famous stand in American history, in the face of the most powerful military on the planet at the time. Nine patriots died that early morning on April 19, 1775, on the Lexington commons. They died for me! They died for you!

The countryside became alive with patriots, who drove the British enemy back into Boston. The Americans seized the highground at Charlestown, north of Boston, across the Charles River, and began to fortify it. The British knowing that the City of Boston would be an untenable position if the patriots got cannon atop Breed's Hill, decided to attack. The British made two amphibious landings, at the east and south of the Charlestown peninsula. The enemy sent wave after wave of frontal assaults at the Americans' redoubts, only to be mowed down by assault weapons, i.e. muskets being fired and reloaded in two man teams, a shooter and a reloader, to put as much lead on the enemy as possible. For most of the patriots it was their first combat experience. Their fortification was a mixture of earth, wood and hay bales.

About the third frontal assault the patriots left flank was precariously undefended, when John Stark showed up with his New Hampshire militia and quickly realized the situation and shared up the left flank, reeking heavy casualties on the enemy. In the middle of all this was Joseph Warren commanding and urging the American Patriots to stand their ground and be brave. Some patriots moved down the hill into the buildings of Charlestown. The British seeing this maneuver, shelled the town, burning it to the ground. I

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should mention the peninsula was surrounded by British warships firing into the Americans' fortification. The tales of bay caught fire coupled with all the musket fire; one can just imagine the smoke and chaos.

Dr. Warren was wounded by a musket ball. Running low on ammo and their redoubt pretty much destroyed, they retreated just a little to Bunker's Hill, which was a harder position to defend. The British seeing this retreat did an all out assault finally breaking through the Americans' line of defense. Hand to hand combat ensued, but many patriots fled because their rifles did not have bayonets and the ammo was completely exhausted. Dr. Warren could not retreat because of his wound, fighting till he was bayoneted several times, dying for you and I that Saturday afternoon on June 17, 1775.

During the battle of Breed's Hill (misnamed Battle of Bunker's Hill) the patriots killed more British officers, than would be killed the entire rest of the war combined. I relate this page of history to my reader to let him understand what type of character is needed in today's patriots, if we are to defeat our enemy. Joseph Warren was a widow with four young children. He knew he was fighting for their future to be free from government oppression. He was willing to give his life, the ultimate sacrifice, and unfortunately did, for not just his children, but for millions of children yet unborn.

We know history repeats itself; and here we are, we come full circle. The enemy is best on disarming us. Whether it is through incrementalism or one fell swoop, makes no difference, because the reality of the enemy's goal remains the same. With each new

arms control law, we are told this is the fix all to end all, meaning this should cure the problem, we will not seek any more gun control. The 1968 Gun Control Act (passed after the enemy killed Kennedy, a King) was partially derived from Nazi Germany's gun control laws. Then the Brady Bill, and now outright bans and registration. Everyday we wait to unite and actively resist, we get weaker as the enemy gets stronger.

When it was announced by the Crown that all judges will be appointed by the King's Governor and paid by the King instead of being elected by the legislature and paid by the provincial treasury, do you know what the colonist did? To counter the Massachusetts Government Act, one week before the Worcester County Court of Common Pleas was to meet, citizens throughout the county gathered and declared themselves a "Convention" (which also had been outlawed) and proclaimed themselves a "Convention" (which also had been outlawed) and proclaimed that the court could not sit, and the committee recommended that "inhabitants of this County attend in Person," and in case any redecoated soldiers accompanied the judges, it suggested the people come "properly armed in order to repel any hostile force which may be employed." The convention made clear what "properly armed" entailed: "that each member will purchase at least two pounds of powder in addition to any he may have on hand, and will use all his exertions to supply his neighbors fully."

Thomas Edge, who was the new military governor, who replaced Governor Hutchinson, wrote nervously to the Earl of Dartmouth: "In Worcester they keep no terms; openly threaten resistance by arms; have been purchasing arms; preparing them; casting balls, and providing powder; and threaten to attack any troops who dare oppose them." Today the enemy's government would label this terrorism, may be so, our

founding fathers were all terrorists, plain and simple.

On September 6, 1774 when the crown appointed judges showed up at the Worcester County Courthouse to conduct business, they were greeted with an estimated 5,000 to 6,000 men, including 1,000 armed militiamen organized neatly into rank and file on the town green. They read their repudiation of the Act and forced the judges to resign or else. This scene was carried out at Erret Barrington, Plymouth, Taunton, Concord, Springfield and throughout the colony. A Crown appointed attorney named Timothy Paine had 2,000-3,000 people show up at his house demanding his resignation or else. Mr. Paine was forced to come outside and to sign and read aloud his resignation. The same went for John Murray. Each of the enemy's instruments of oppression were confronted and dealt with accordingly. The ones that resisted were tarred + feathered and if they still resisted they were hanged. As the noose was around their neck, they were given their resignation to read aloud one last time, which many obliged the "body of the people."

The reason I tear this page from history to put before my reader, is to show you how the people were united and were not afraid, but filled with courage to meet the enemy. Again history lets us know terror was the chosen tactic of our venerable forefathers.

I must point out that in February 1775 the enemy sent Colonel Leslie out of Boston with 240 men to seize the arms and ammunition which the rebels had stored in Salem, Massachusetts. As noted by eyewitness William Travett, old Mr. James Barr and others lifted the Northfield drawbridge as the troops approached the town.

Colonel Leslie shouted to drop the drawbridge, that he was on the King's Highway, to which Mr Barr replied, "It is not the King's Highway; it is a road built by the owners of the lots on the other side, and no King, country or town has anything to do with it." Colonel Leslie was amazed he was spoken to like that. After some bickering, Colonel Leslie promised he would only march 50 rods without disturbing anything if the bridge was lowered. The bridge was lowered and Colonel Leslie kept his promise, thus the opening battle of the American Revolution was postponed for two months. Old Mr. Barr stood up to the British Empire. That is true American Bravery.

No Freeman or woman would ever register their liberty tools. Do you think for one second Dr. Warren or Old man Barr would register their "assault weapons"? Of course not! You would have to fight me and kill me first. The enemy bleeds too! As every creature in nature was given a mechanism for self-defense by God, man was given the rifle + pistol as their best mechanism for self-preservation. Simply put - the rifle and the pistol are a free peoples' teeth to their liberty. And when they are sought to be deprived from you, that deprivor seeks to deprive you of your liberty. "Liberty is as precious as life, and if any man attempts to take my life, I have a right to take his, therefore: if a man attempts to take away my liberty, I have a [natural] right to take his life, also when the Peoples' liberties are threatened, they are in a state of war, and have a [natural] right to defend themselves." This statement is in the public record. It was recorded at a townhall meeting in September 1768 at Faneuil Hall. Note: Peter Faneuil, the builder of the "Cradle of Liberty" was born at New Rochelle, New York in 1700.

In closing, I urge my readers, no I beg my readers to do something to emancipate posterity. I suggest organizing groups of patriotic citizens in each county, especially in New York, where the war is at a fever pitch. Share ideas. I expect the enemy to send their spies amongst you, so act and adjust accordingly. Most importantly get the people to take the oath! Anyone refusing to take the oath should be looked upon as an accessory to the enemy. Proclaim your repudiation of any registration of liberty tools. Like our forefathers taught us, mass demonstrations in the enemy's face to show the enemy we are not afraid to stand for our natural rights and beliefs.
