O New York, O New Yorkers, O my native New York my long agitated mind cannot vibrate to a rest knowing your current situation. A situation that reminds those who know, and for those yet to learn, that every species of government will eventually become a despotism without exception, and reduce our boasted liberties down to the standard of licensed privileges.

When the People of New York united to establish and write down the political law by which they thought best to secure the blessings of liberty, in a document called a constitution, the people did not grant their government the power to alter the political law. Any civil law that alters the political law is null and void. Only the People in their sovereign capacity in convention can alter the state constitution or political law. All too often, the generosity which flows from the people towards their governments, in a stream so copious as to wash away the foundations of their liberty; is used in modes which have enslaved them. A good government is a frugal government. A bad government is one of extravagance.

A corrupt government has reason to fear the wrath of the People. A corrupt government has an incentive to disarm the ones it is fleecing. The corrupt governments of the socialists, New York, California, Maryland, Connecticut and Illinois just to name a few, are the ones disarming the people. These overgrown corrupt governments constantly propose as a remedy more power to suppress the disorders they produced. No government has a right to disarm the People, let alone, a corrupt government. Freedom can be measured by the weapons the people allow themselves to possess.

A moneyed aristocracy has been created in not only this nation, but in the world. Their enormous wealth gives them enormous political power. This faceless aristocracy seeks control

over the globe. Socialist governments are their weapon of choice. They purchase control of governments either by the party or by the politician. We will gratify your greed if you gratify our ambition. The politicians do not represent us, they represent the moneyed aristocracy and their party. We must attend to our rights. An armed populace are in fact bestowed the trust necessary for the preservation of their liberty; and if they passively surrender their right to bear militia arms, they are surrendering their power to defend liberty.
