## WHAT TO LOOK FOR

A broad spectrum sunscreen, meaning it covers both UVA and UVB. Best are those with Zinc oxide or Titanium Dioxide.

American Academy of Dermatology and Highlander Dermatology recommends 30+(or higher) broad spectrum SPF

Sunlight consists of two types of harmful rays that reach the Earth — UVA rays and UVB rays. Overexposure to either can lead to skin cancer. In addition to causing skin cancer, here's what each of these rays do:

- UVA rays (or aging rays) can prematurely age your skin, causing wrinkles and age spots, and can pass through window glass.
- UVB rays (or burning rays) are the primary cause of sunburn and are blocked by window glass.

There is no safe way to tan. Every time you tan, you damage your skin. As this damage builds, you speed up the aging of your skin and increase your risk for all types of skin cancer. Look for the words "water resistant." No sunscreen is completely waterproof, but water-resistant sunscreens can provide protection for wet or sweaty skin for 80 minutes, or more (240 minutes with Blue Lizard!) as indicated on the label. All sunscreens should be reapplied every two hours, or after swimming or sweating. For sensitive skin, choose a sunscreen without fragrance, oils and para-aminobenzoic acid. (also known as PABA).
