

"Standardized" dividers

All John's Woodworks storage drawers will now come set up for dividers! After many requests I have come up (with input from users) with a system that is practical to make yet will meet the needs of most every customer. Here is how it works: From now on, all my drawers will have a groove, front and back that will accept a slip fit divider. These grooves will be standard features at no increase in cost. The grooves will be located $7 \frac{1}{2}$ to $8 \frac{1}{4}$ " from the left inside surface of the drawer depending on the cooler type and drawer configuration. This will accept all your longer 6 to $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " cigars. The right side of the divider will vary depending on your model of cooler. There will be friction fit horizontal dividers for each side of the main divider. I will call them "long" and "short". The main vertical divider will be called "main". There will be a "standard divider kit" available for each drawer that I make. The kit will consist of a main, a long, and a short divider and will sell for \$15.00. Additional long and short dividers will be available at \$3.00 each. Of course, the dividers will be matched to your drawer heights. One of the advantages of this system is there is a great deal of standardization (my benefit) and they are decoupled from the drawer and can be ordered or upgraded at any time (your benefit). You can order more long and short dividers at any time because I will have a record of what you have. For those who will be ordering trays I will offer the same system but because the materials involved are lighter (thinner) I would prefer to install them at the time of manufacture; same pricing (it will be an upcharge to the tray) and will have the same benefit of ordering more horizontal dividers at a later date.
