Project Summary

Jemison & Partners, Inc. prepared a competitive state grant application for the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans on the Nashville Avenue Terminal Paving Improvements project from the Louisiana Port Construction and Development Priority (Port Priority) Program. The project is located at the Port of New Orleans in New Orleans, Louisiana, at the Nashville Avenue Terminal, 99.8 to 101.1 ahead of passes on the Eastbank of the Mississippi River.

The project is estimated to cost \$21 million in construction, with \$15

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million requested from Port Priority funding and \$6 million in Port NOLA funding.



The Nashville Avenue Terminal Paving *Improvements* project consists of the demolition of 17.3 acres existing concrete pavers, construction of heavy-duty concrete paving in place of the pavers, demolition and replacement of 3,887 linear feet of existing rail track along perimeter of the area to be paved, installation of underground utilities. removal of the existing drainage system and installation of a new drainage system, removal of existing

wooden lighting poles and installation of high-mast lighting, and the installation of fencing and striping.

The project is recommended for approval of funding by the Louisiana Department of transportation and Development in the spring of 2017, pending approval by the LA State Legislature.
