Patron Code of Conduct

1. Patron Code of Conduct

In order to ensure future use of High School facilities and services, as well as the personal comfort of all patrons and students, the DRHS Drama Boosters has established the following code of conduct:

1.1 Reasonably appropriate and reserved behavior is expected on school property. No patron may disturb or



harass other patrons, students or volunteer staff. Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to verbal abuse, sexually suggestive interaction with students, physical altercations or committing any act that would violate any State, Federal or local law, ordinance, or regulation.

- **1.2** Patrons are required to wear acceptable clothing, including shirts and footwear. Patrons shall maintain a generally acceptable standard of personal hygiene.
- **1.3** Damage to school property or disruption of service including, but not limited to, building, grounds, and media equipment is prohibited.
- 1.4 Drinking of alcoholic beverages, smoking of tobacco products, and/or the use of illegal substances are not permitted on school grounds per Gilbert Public Schools guidelines. All off-campus beverage containers must be clearly visible and identifiable at all times.
- **1.5** Patrons with service animals may be asked to provide documentation for them.
- **1.6** Patrons are expected to leave the school property within three hours after completion of the car show.
- **1.7** Patrons are expected to adhere to this, all additional school policies, and any directions given to them by car show volunteer staff.
- **1.8** Individuals of all ages are expected to follow these rules. Any individuals who violate this Code of Conduct may be banned from the school property and future car shows and/or prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- **1.9** If a patron is to witness any behavior which breaks these rules, patrons should report these violations to event staff. Law enforcement will be called if necessary.
