As a vice president, he co-created and managed an Event Management Company, staging annual ethnic festivals at Ontario Place, managing trade exhibits and hosting trade missions. During the period 1991 – 1995, he served two terms as a member of the Community Reference Group on Ethno-Racial and Aboriginal Access to Metropolitan Toronto Inc. Services advising Metro Toronto administration on a wide range of municipal issues. He currently also serves as a member of the Chief of Toronto Police Advisory Council. For 10 years he was the president of the Canada – Poland Chamber of Commerce of Toronto organization dedicated to development of economical exchange between Poland and Canada.

In 2009, he was appointed by Privy Council and currently serves as a Citizenship Judge. At the Canada-Poland Chamber of Commerce of Toronto he presently holds the position of President.



### Tristan Black



Tristan Black is a former professional athlete who spent six years playing in the Canadian Football league. His introduction to the league was first with the Calgary Stampeders. Unfortunately, he spent most of his time with the Stampeders beating the odds and coming back from what most doctors said was a career-ending foot injury. He was then traded to his hometown of Toronto where he spent the next 3 seasons playing for the Toronto Argonauts. In his time with the Argonauts, the team won the 100th

Grey Cup. The following year he signed as a free agent to the Saskatchewan Roughrider football club where he again helped the team win the 101st Grey Cup.

During his time in the CFL, Tristan founded a non-profit organization called 'True North Strong'. Through their main program "The Canadian Football Factory", the organization focused on giving Toronto's student-athletes the tools needed to use their athletic ability to get to the next level in education, personal and professional lives. In its first year, the organization was able to assist 95% of its senior class in enrolling into Universities in both the United States and Canada, many through athletic scholarships. "I just wanted to make sure that none of them made the same mistake that I did when I was coming out".

During the end of his athletic career, Tristan along with one of his teammates formed a transportation company which specialized in the oil and gas industry. Most recently through his Neon Black Inc., he is currently working with several startup companies in a business development role. He hopes to provide the same value for young entrepreneurs as he did with his student-athletes, by sharing his resources and relationships, allowing them to mobilise their talents in order to follow their dreams.



## Congress of Black Women—Brampton



The Ontario Region of the Congress of Black Women of Canada is a regional body with a number of local chapters linked to the National Congress of Black Women of Canada. It provides leadership and direction to create and maintain links among the Ontario Chapters of the Congress of Black Women in their missions to address the social, economic and cultural issues and needs of black women, regardless of ability, age, ancestry, citizenship,

class, culture, ethnicity, family status, and marital status, place of birth, political affiliation, region or sexual orientation. The Congress of Black Women of Canada will promote organizational visibility, facilitate consistency of leadership and coordinate the concerns and issues of all Ontario Chapters.

### Jermaine Granville



Jermaine Granville an Immigrant from Jamaica who migrated to Canada in the 90's and has been an active member in the community ever since., promoting youth awareness programs.

Jermaine is known by many as Mr. Western, as he was the Community Promotional Manager for Western Union for 10 years. Since 2017, Jermaine has opened his own Business as a Promoter and Producer where he now has the opportunity to spend quality time with his two (2) sons while still giving back to the community producing cultural and empowerment activities.



## Raynier Maharaj



Raynier Maharaj is a name well-known across the Canadian landscape as one of the country's most experienced journalists in the multicultural communities who has been serving the country's diverse communities for the last 28 years.

Maharaj's name grabbed national attention in 1990 when, as a new immigrant in Canada less than one year, he took a leap of faith and started The Caribbean Camera, a weekly newspaper for Caribbean Canadians. Maharaj saw the need for a new paper to become the voice of a unified community of Caribbean Canadians, as existing publications at the time were targeting their readers on the basis of race.

In 1992, Maharaj was offered a post as a columnist for the Toronto Sun, and quickly became a household name in Toronto because of his spirited opinions on diversity issues which had, at the time, torn apart the fabric of race relations in Canada's biggest and most multicultural city.

Maharaj continued the weekly column for four years, while still managing editorial affairs at The Camera. In 1997, he stepped aside from his duties at The Sun to meet the challenges of managing The Camera in what was becoming an increasingly difficult market for newspapers. He steered the paper until 2014.

In 2007, Maharaj put his newspapering skills to the test once again when he created the Durham Citizen, a newspaper geared towards the multicultural community of Durham, east of Toronto, after learning that over a two years period, more than 50,000 people of colour had moved into the burgeoning region. He discovered there was no newspaper serving that diversity.

The Citizen, to date, remains the only newspaper serving the multicultural communites of that region. It is now under the stewardship of a new publisher.

After leaving The Camera in 2014, Maharaj rose to what he saw at his biggest challenge: developing a new paper utilizing technological advancements to reach readers in multicultural communities across Canada.

He developed The Independent, a bi-weekly digital newspaper for minorities in the Diaspora, which is the only newspaper of its kind in the country. It was developed because Maharaj felt that minorities who move to Canada, whatever their ethnicity or country of origin, have issues in common, as well as similar interests and needs, such as housing, transport, jobs, education, etc.

Purely digital, the paper serves a readership of over 33,500 across Canada, as it is not limited to geographical regions because of its unique method of circulation. The Independent is available only through subscription, and is delivered to readers directly to their smart devices or computers. There is no online or print version.

The Independent recently partnered with the global digital platform Joom to offer the paper to 5 million readers around the world. It is the only paper of its kind on Joom, which is based in California and Argentina.

In October 2016, The Independent was named by the National Ethnic Press and Media Council of Canada as the Best Digital Newspaper in Canada, and in a ceremony that followed at the Lt. Governor General's office at Queen's Park, Maharaj was conferred with an Honorary Degree for his service to the community.

His understanding of multicultural communities and his sensitivity to their issues and beliefs are perhaps second to none, as his experience crosses all social, ethnic and geographic barriers.

Karlene Grant is a registered social worker, she completed her Bachelors of Social Work Degree at the University of Ryerson and her Masters at the University of Windsor. She has 20 years of experience in the field of mental health and is trained in Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), Solution Focus Therapy and in Trauma work. Karlene is also a registered safeTALK trainer, with Livingworks. In this role Karlene provides training in suicide intervention and has

done so within the community and at the William Osler Hospital.

Karlene has worked as a therapist at the Child & Adolescent Clinic (William Osler Health System) providing individual and family counselling to youth under the age of 19 with a mental health diagnosis. She has also worked closely with the clinic psychiatrists to provide additional support during assessments. Prior to joining the William Osler Health System, Karlene was working in the community as a therapist, mental health court worker and crisis worker with COAST (Crisis Outreach and Support Team).

Karlene has been in private practice for the past 14 years and has extensive experience in custody and access, parenting coordination and mental health. Karlene continues to provide support and therapy to individuals and families using evidence based and research advised therapies. Ontario Enrichment Counselling Centre is located in Mississauga and Brampton and offers weekdays as well as weekend appointments.



### **Princess Boucher**





She is the founder of the International Women Achievers' Awards, the Princess Fae Peer Mediation Center and the president and C.E.O of Princess Promotions Enter-

prise.

The entertainment company is designed and structured to interlock with today's trend, mixing it with the past to create the near future and beyond. As an event planner, she said her constant interaction with people from different communities and cultures provided her with an understanding of some of their concerns and decided that it was time to take action and launched her political campaign in 2010 for Brampton City council and in 2014 Toronto City Council. CocoNatty formed the Manning Youth group where they travelled to Parish close to their hometown performing. He formed the Shackles

Drama group where he wrote several plays and also for the Tacky Secondary School which was performed at the School.

CocoNatty was a student at the Jamaica School of Drama, due to Financial difficulties he did not complete his Diploma but during his enrollment he captured all he could and embraced himself with the theoretical knowledge adding to his practical knowledge and experiences.

Coconatty went to Cuba for 2 years where he embarked once again into Community involvement and worked in Social work and Community development. CocoNatty has worked with Peter Tosh, The Band Fab Five, Unique Vision and has also recorded for Universal Records.


