Guests and Clients all added to the artwork which was designed to include the branches of AIM throughout Queensland and Darwin.



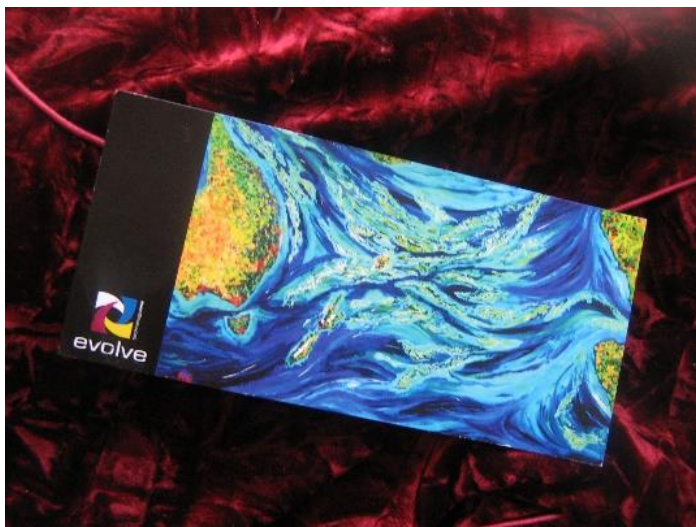
The Australian Turf Club commissioned Donna to paint an artwork commemorating the merger of the Sydney racing clubs.
