Self Funding Auction item


In most cases, Donna's painting exceeds all other auction prices getting on average 50% plus than other auction items.

Donna has many private and corporate clients who purchase at auction or commission Donna every year to add to their collection of her work. Donna's paintings are not available in galleries which keeps her work exclusive.

After comprehensive research, Donna will design a painting in keeping with the theme of your event. This means Donna can paint a one off piece of art, which cannot be bought elsewhere, and is unique to your event. Often Celebrities and Identities add to Donna's Canvas, and then they sign the front. The painting is created throughout the night/day, from a blank canvas to a finished painting in front of your guests. This also provides tangible entertainment.

An Exclusive and Entertaining Auction Item

Often celebrities are invited to fundraising events, but what role do they have at the event? By inviting them to add to the canvas, it gives them something tangible to take part in. Guests at the event also enjoy watching their favourite celebrities/identities adding to the canvas.

A real Bonus is that there is no risk to the charity what so ever. Donna has very fair auction terms. The fees are as follows.

For Auction price up to and including \$5000.00. the fee payable is 50%

For Auction price over \$5000.00 up to and including \$9999.00, the fee is \$3500.00

For Auction price from and including \$10000.00 up to \$14999.00 the fee is \$4000.00

For Auction price from and including \$15000.00 up to \$19999.00 the fee is \$5500.00

For Auction price from and including \$20000.00 up to \$25000.00 the fee is \$7**0**00.00

For Auction price from and including \$25000.00 up to \$30000.00 the fee is \$10000.00

Travel costs additional. Negotiated directly depending on location.

How does it work?

Donna sets up her easel and canvas where guests are invited to add to the canvas.

This is usually during the pre-dinner drinks, when there is nothing else formal happening. It is an opportunity to provide a unique interactive entertainment at the beginning of the event. Then Donna moves to the stage, where only celebrities/identities are invited to add to her canvas throughout the rest of the event. This does not take away from other activities and formalities.

The MC refers to Donna, and often Donna will have a roving mic, providing opportunities for Donna to interview her "Celebrity artist" as well.

It is important that the guests see that the painting will be a valuable one off piece of art. Donna's paintings are not available in galleries, and only via commission or the auction process. The winning bidder also has the opportunity for Donna to personalise their painting by adding in their own corporate logo, or painting them into the canvas.

Added Benefits

Often prints of the original art work are then sold after the original. Limited runs of 5 to 10 prints are auctioned for between \$500 and \$1000.00 dollars. Highest print has reached \$8000.00 at auction.
