Most builders only offer ranch style homes with a basement, so what Level 1 Homes provides is a rare commodity. "I interviewed ranch style home buyers, and found that most people rarely went into their basement," says Clint Dufresne, founder and builder at Level 1 Homes. "In a one-level home there is no wasted space, it's all living space."

Every single part of a Level 1 home is accessible. Hallways and doorways are made wider to comfortably fit a wheel chair if need be, and there are even curb-less showers for easy in-and-out access. "We accommodate aging in place," says Ellie Bishop, Project Manager for Level 1 Homes. "So this way, even if you buy the home

when you're 30 or 40, you can remain there comfortably into your 80s, 90s and even 100s." One-level homes are widely popular in areas like Florida and Texas, driven in part by their convenience and overall stylistic appeal, but it's rare to come across single level living in the state of Colorado.

Level 1 Homes is also special because it is a full-custom building company. "We have never built the same home twice," says Bishop. Mike McCoy, Government Compliance Officer at Level 1 Homes, says "When you're building a custom home, you get a chance to form a relationship with clients rather than just seeing it as a transaction. This journey is shared between builder and owner all the way through."
