Birdwatching



North Brigantine Beach - East Beach Avenue and 14th Street North, Brigantine, NJ

SITE DESCRIPTION: There are few opportunities to explore relatively undisturbed beach in New Jersey, and North Brigantine Beach is one of them. Over two miles of sandy beach and salt marsh are home to species common in coastal marine habitats including gulls, minnows, sand crabs and diamondback terrapins. The large, two-story viewing platform is a wonderful place to camp out during spring and fall migration season and provides an excellent vantage point from which to scan for sea birds and marine mammals. The undeveloped shrub/scrub habitat between the fore-dune and the platform attracts passerine species and small mammals. This is a popular beach for surf fishing through most of the year.

DON'T MISS: Visit in early spring to see endangered Piping Plovers arriving and establishing nesting territories along the beach.

Birdwatching

THROUGH THE SEASONS:


Winter: Winter provides opportunities to observe diving ducks such as Long-tailed Duck, Scoters, Loons, Double Crested and occasionally Great Cormorant. Small flocks of Sanderlings work the surf. Winter is the best time to scan for Bonaparte's gull and other seasonal rarities over the ocean.

Spring: Spring brings opportunities to observe migratory and local birds, particularly shorebirds. Nesting Piping Plover may be observed from the beach, beginning in mid-March. Look for various sandpiper species stopping over, as well as songbirds such as Common Yellowthroat and Yellow Warbler in the shrubs. Glossy Ibis, egrets and herons return to the marsh in late April and early May.

Summer: Diamondback terrapins nest on the bay-side beaches. Surf fishing is good for striped bass, bluefish, summer flounder, kingfish, skate, smooth dogfish and croaker. Pods of bottlenose dolphin can be seen close to shore. Shorebirds dart along the surf line after invertebrates. Piping Plover, Black Skimmer, American Oystercatcher and Least Tern are among endangered species nesting on the beach. Osprey carry fish to their nestlings. At dusk, ghost crabs and Clapper Rails become active.

Fall: Monarch butterflies stop to nectar on the seaside goldenrod as they journey South. Shorebird migrants such as Least and Semipalmated Sandpiper, Semipalmated and Black-bellied Plover, Dowitchers and occasionally Marbled Godwits feed along the rack line and mudflats. Watch for Peregrine Falcons and other raptors overhead, and for Royal and Caspian Terns amongst flocks of Forster's and Common Tern. Northern Gannets and Brown Pelicans pass further offshore.

SPECIAL FEATURES: The impressive two-story viewing platform offers shelter from the elements, and an excellent vantage point for wildlife observation.



Ecotourism



Brigantine has made the way to the top of the list as New Jersey's best towns for ecotourism. Brigantine even has a Marine Mammal Stranding Center, which nurses sick marine mammals back to health before releasing them back to their natural habitats. One last thing: don't be surprised if you see a horse on the north end beaches. Horseback riding is a secret activity that locals and tourists alike are often unaware of!

Fishing

Brigantine has quickly risen to be one of the top surf fishing destinations on the East coast.

The Island is very fish friendly and we cater to all anglers needs from beginners to experts. In the Spring and Fall you can access the beaches with a 4 X 4 permit and drive up and down the entire length of the Island by truck (with a valid 4 X 4 Brigantine permit). The Striper and Black Drum migration comes through Brigantine twice a year and they usually hang around here for 3 months at a time.

Starting in the middle of March until the middle of June you have the spring run when the fish are all heading north and they will return in the middle of September until the end of the year. All summer long we have flounder, blue fish, king fish, weak fish and spot along with many other species that enjoy the waters of our Island. The best part of fishing in Brigantine is that you can enjoy the surf fishing or drop your boat in using the



Golf



The **Links at Brigantine Beach**, one of the oldest and most historic golf courses in the Atlantic City area, was built in 1927 as part of Brigantine Island's master plan. True to its historic Scottish roots, the links style layout offers breathtaking bay views, as it winds through native marsh and gently rolling, nearly treeless terrain. With sea breezes, water hazards, and carefully placed concave bunkers, this 18-hole, par 72 course provides an exciting experience for golfers of all skill levels.

With a prevailing ocean wind that characterizes true links golf, holes can play completely differently from one day to another. "While many courses claim to be like the original links courses of the British Isles, Brigantine Golf Links delivers...you'd swear you were across the pond." – Washington Golf Monthly noted.

Our secret – local Atlantic City golf history suggests that golfing legends from the 1920s practiced their bump-and-run golf game at Brigantine in the early summer months before sailing for the British Open. If true, Walter Hagen was well prepared for his 1928 and 1929 Championships.



Stand-Up Paddle Boarding



The fast-growing sport of stand-up paddle boarding (SUP) is a fun, easy way to go play on the water. With a minimum of equipment, you can paddle anything from the Brigantine Ocean Surf to the Back Bays of Brigantine and best of all—no waves required. Look at the pictures of paddleboarders having a great time at the Brigantine Cove..

Paddleboarding offers an amazing full body workout and is becoming a favorite cross-training activity for skiers, snowboarders and other athletes. And since you're standing at your full height, you'll enjoy excellent views of everything from sea creatures to what's on the horizon. It's almost like walking on water! So grab those boards and head to Brigantine Pristine Waters....

Paddle Boarding Gear

You need just a few key pieces of equipment to enjoy this sport:

- Stand up paddleboard: This is by far your most significant gear investment. Sizes are based on the paddler's weight and experience. More experienced and lighter paddlers can choose narrower boards. Novice paddlers should choose wider, flatter boards, which offer more stability.
- Paddle: Stand up paddles have an angle or "elbow" in the shaft for maximum efficiency. Choose a paddle that's roughly 6" to 8" taller than you are (though some manufacturers recommend an 8" to 10" differential).
- PFD (Personal Flotation Device): The U.S. Coast Guard classifies stand up paddleboards as vessels, so always wear a PFD whenever you're paddling navigable water.
- Proper clothing: For cold conditions where hypothermia is a concern, wear a wetsuit or dry suit. In milder conditions, wear shorts and a T-shirt or bathing suit—something that moves with you and can get wet.
- Sun protection: Wear sunscreen and sunglasses.

Surfing



Surfing is lifetime favorite activity for locals and tourists alike in Brigantine. With waves that anyone from a beginner to a pro loves riding, it's no wonder why so many people keep a surfboard close by in this town. Head down to the beach at 38th Street South or use your Four Wheel Drive Permit to drive onto the Jetty Beach, Brigantine's own surfer paradise where cars are parked along the beach, barbeque is going, and surfer's come in and out of the water.

Surfers must stay outside the flags that designate the swimming areas in front of the lifeguard stands.? The following beaches are guarded designated surfing beaches: the south end jetty beach, 9th street south and the north end beach (12th Street).? Each beach offers it's own unique break and is worth exploring.? Beginners should avoid the crowded surfing beaches and learn proper surfing etiquette to be safe and keep fellow surfers safe.? Remember to never surf past your ability level and always surf with a companion.

Swimming

Swimming is permitted on guarded beaches from June 15th to Labor Day during the hours of 10:00 am - 5:30 pm, while the lifeguards are on duty.



Aside from swimming at the beach and bay, Brigantine offers at 25-meter indoor pool for those who like to get their early morning laps in. Located at 3118 Bayshore Avenue, the Brigantine Aquatic Club offers open swim hours, lessons and even a competing swim team.

Brigantine Aquatic Club is a privately run facility with a heated indoor pool with deep and shallow ends. The pool is keep at 84 degrees' year round as well as the pool room. There is a cardio workout room with basic equipment. The locker rooms consist of showers, lockers, steam rooms and saunas. Water aerobics classes are 6 times a week and arthritis classes through the Arthritis Foundation are 2 times a week.
