

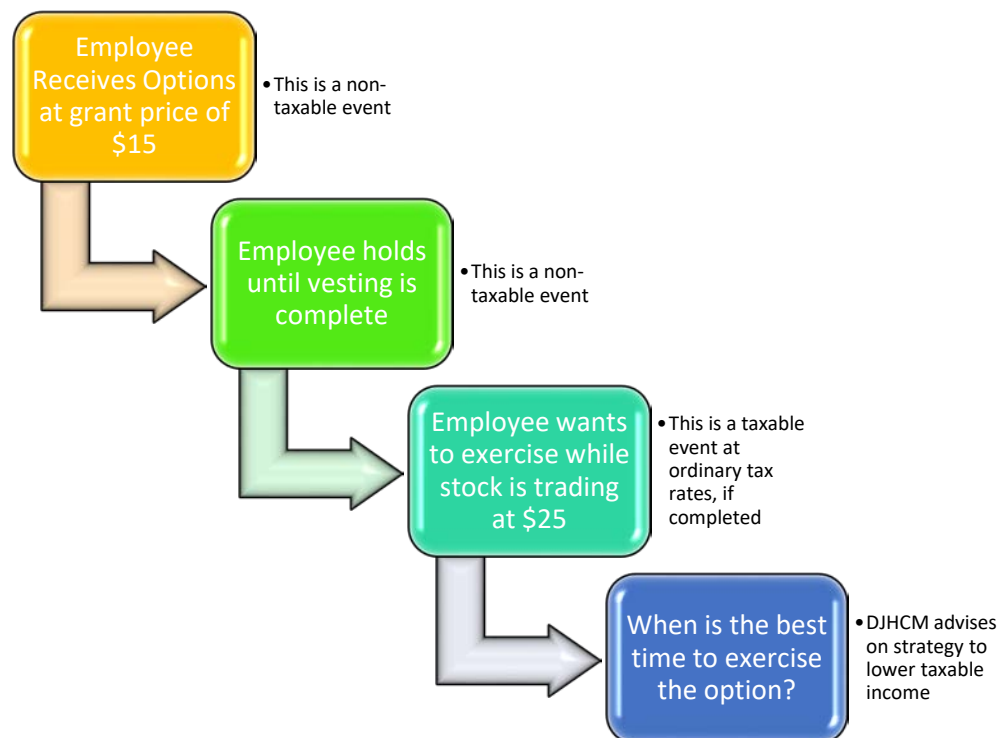


Creating an Option Exercise Schedule
