RED FLAGS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

- Disconnected from family and friends?
- A child not attending school?
- A sudden or dramatic change in behavior?
- A juvenile engaged in commercial sex acts?
- Disoriented, unexplainable withdrawal
- Confused or showing signs of abuse?
- Fearful, timid or submissive?
- Denied food, water, sleep, or medical care?
- Does someone control of their activities?
- Do they appear to be coached on what to say?
- Do they live in unsuitable conditions?
- Do they have few personal possessions?
- Can they leave? Extreme security measures?
- Older boyfriend or all new friends
- Talks about wild parties and invites other kids

RED FLAGS DURING A HOTEL STAY

- Minors left in a room that show signs of abuse, appear helpless, confused, and nervous?
- DO NOT DISTURB sign used constantly or housekeeping services refused for many days?
- Guests on an extended stay with little luggage?
- A minor requesting or refusing services?
- Adults who loiter in hallways or monitor the area?
- Minor with multiple cell phones, or electronics?
- Minors left in the room for long periods of time?
- Children's items or clothing present but no child is registered in that room?
- Many guests staying in one room?
- Minor present in the room during school hours?
- Large amounts of cash, credit card swipes, multiple laptops, pagers, or cell phones?

PIMPS/TRAFFICKERS BEHAVIORS

- Jealous, controlling and violent
- Significantly older than female companions
- Promise things that seem too good to be true
- Encourage victims to engage in illegal activities
- Buys or owns expensive items
- Is vague about his/her profession
- Pushy or demanding about sex
- Encourages inappropriate sexual behavior


