Historical Accomplishments – What Timberlake Civic Association has done for you:

- √ Helped create Tri State Park District in 1958
- √ Represented Timberlake at Zoning meetings for multiple developments in the area
- √ Stopped chemical plant from being built on South Frontage Road and Cass Avenue
- √ Opposed and defeated the placement of a 30' X 50' X 60' billboard on south Frontage Rd.
- √ Fought the placement of a billboard on I – 55 and it was removed
- √ Stopped the building of 8-flat apartment buildings on N.E. corner of Clarendon Hills Rd. & S. Frontage Road and the building of townhouses where the Clarendon Heights subdivision now resides
- √ Partnered with Darien residents to prevent the building of a large trucking company on S. Frontage Rd. near Cass Ave.
- √ Partnered with others in preventing Argonne National Lab from becoming a nuclear waste disposal site
- √ Supported the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County in the acquisition of open space near Lorraine Dr. and 87th St.
- √ Worked with Tri-State Park District to expand Weber Park to connect with Sunrise Park and acquire land for
- √ Little Creek Park on North Williams Drive.
- √ Successfully resisted being incorporated into neighboring municipalities
- √ Timberlake is represented at the Argonne National Lab Community Leaders Round Table
- √ Coordinated the spraying of gypsy moths saving hundreds of majestic oak trees in Timberlake
- √ Worked with Downers Grove Township in reducing our rates for electricity and garbage removal.

Drinking Water: Worked with the Public Works Department to get water mains and hook ups instead of private wells for many residents and in getting Lake Michigan water instead of well water.
