

## **Teller Senior Coalition (TSC)**

To participate in all TSC programs, an application must be completed. For most TSC programs participants must be a minimum of age 60 and a Teller County resident. Contact us for eligibility.

**Transportation:** TSC provides transportation to medical appointments and other essential services for seniors age 60 & older and for income-qualified, disabled adults. **NEMT Medicaid transport** is also available to eligible clients. Call TSC's transportation line for more information: (719)687-0256

**Community Cafe:** We offer fresh cooked, hot lunches at the Senior Center in Woodland Park. (Tuesday-Friday) Call for menu and reservations: (719)687-3877

**Rural Areas Meals:** Seniors may qualify for delivery of frozen or shelf-stable meals. Contact TSC to determine eligibility.

**Chore:** We have local volunteers that improve home safety by making minor repairs or by installing safety devices, such as shower grab-bars.

**Caregiver Support:** To support eligible family caregivers, TSC offers a modest stipend to pay a respite provider to care for a loved one (age 60 and older) while the primary caregiver takes a needed break. In addition, we offer the caregiver the services of a professional counselor.

**Case Management:** Our case manager serves as a senior advocate. She assesses seniors' needs and offers referrals to services provided through TSC programs and other available community resources that strengthen seniors' abilities to remain independent in their homes.

**Legal Aid:** Monthly by appointment only. Legal aid is offered to seniors and qualifying low-income adults. For available dates and to schedule an appointment, please call (719) 687-3330.
