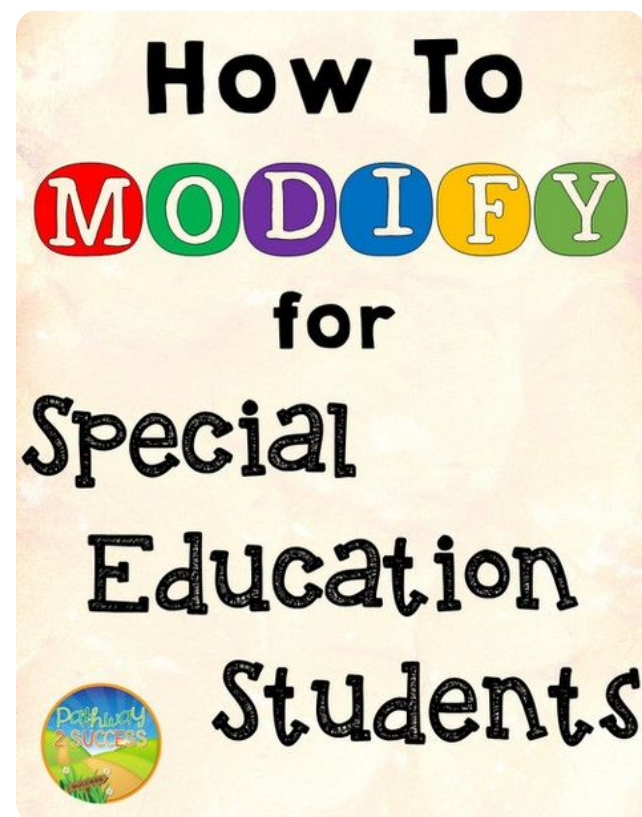

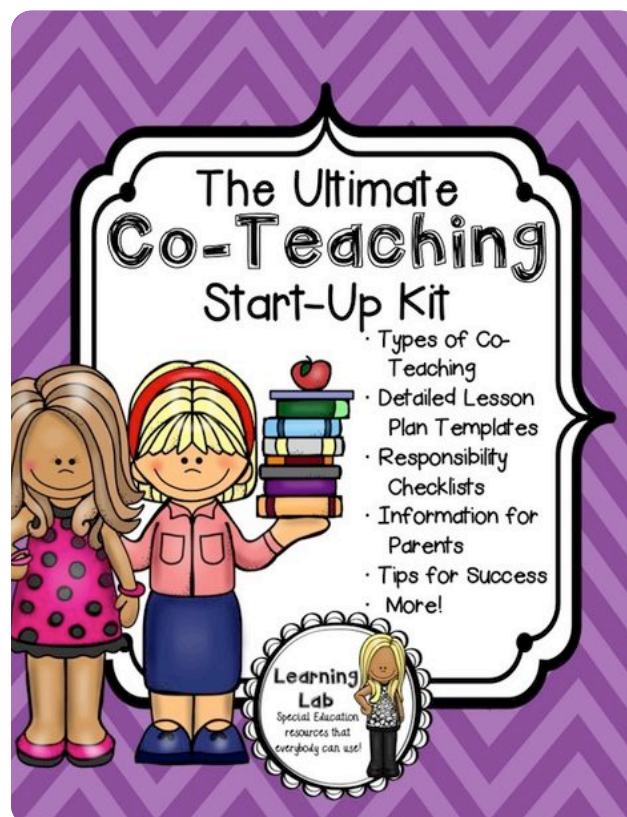

SPECIAL EDUCATION 101

WHAT IS SPECIAL EDUCATION?

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, special education is defined as: "Specially designed instruction to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability." Special education is in place to provide additional services, support, programs, specialized placements or environments to ensure that all students' educational needs are met.

SPECIAL EDUCATION ACCOMMODATIONS

WRITING HW & TESTS

- Use graphic organizers in the planning phase
- Record student's thoughts before beginning to write
- Provide sentence starters and individual word walls
- Write on a computer instead of a notebook
- Use word prediction and spell-check software

- Provides directions in numbered steps
- Read directions and questions aloud
- Allow oral responses
- Limit answer choices and provide fewer questions per page
- Extend time
- Break assignment into smaller chunks

READING

Provide audio recording of the book	Use paired reading and echo reading
Create individualized vocabulary cards with definition + picture	Present visual anchors alongside new vocabulary words
Highlight or underline main idea and supporting details	Use word frames

MATH ORGANIZATION

- Provide a calculator and/or multiplication chart
- Simplify word problems and read them aloud
- Use graph paper to align computation problems
- Use manipulatives to make abstract objects concrete

- Have students fill out planner or calendar
- Remove unnecessary visual stimuli
- Post daily routine
- Use a checklist to track completed tasks

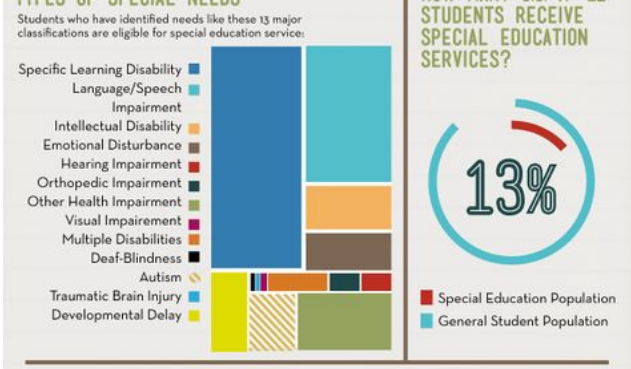

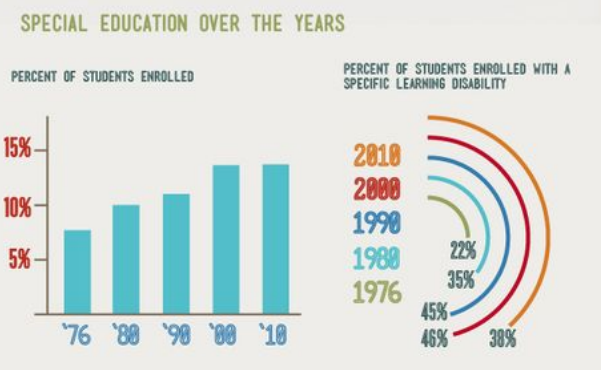

 • a legal document meant to improve the student's educational experience
 • includes: current performance | goals | settings | testing modifications

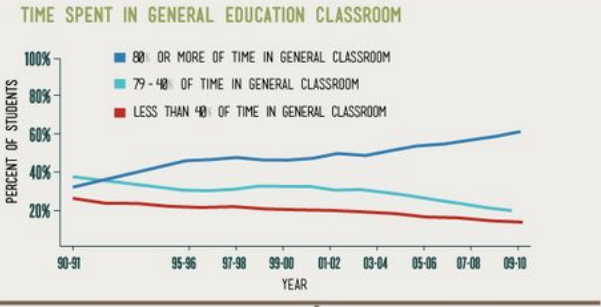
COMMITTEE FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION (CSE)
 • responsible for ensuring the needs of all students with disabilities are met
 • receives referrals for special education services
 • arranges assessment for students to potentially receive services
 • reviews results of assessments
 • collaboratively creates and reviews a student's IEP
 • consists of: the CSE chair/school representative | special education teachers | the students parents/guardians | regular education teachers | assessment experts

STUDENTS' PARENTS

1. I promise to stop calling parents who have high expectations and advocate for their children "high maintenance" and I will equally try to discourage the term "high profile" if due process is involved.
2. I promise to presume competence (always assume that your child can learn and is interested in learning) even if they are unable to communicate to me what they know (yet!)
3. I promise to never use the "R" word and to speak up against it when I hear it used in private or public.
4. I promise to ask your input on the educational goals for your child BEFORE the IEP meeting, and realize that without your collaboration, we have no team.
5. I promise to remember that YOU were your child's first teacher and YOU are an expert on your child...not me.
6. I promise to stop using "what is he/she going to get out of this?" or "they're not ready" as an excuse for not including your child in general education.
7. I promise to never assume I know what goes on at your home or blame your child's challenging behavior at school because of your parenting skills.
8. I promise to Always Be Communicating (ABC) with you about your child (especially the positive things).
9. I promise to keep an open mind and realize that what works with one child does not necessarily work with every child.
10. I promise to always have high expectations for your child and never give up on them...or you.
