Demographics

As of the census of 2010, there are 7,840 people, with 2,945 households, and 2,232 families residing in the City.

There are 3,563 housing units in the City with the racial makeup being:

92.9 % - White

0.3% - Black

0.4% - American Indian and Alaska Native

2.0% - Asian

2.0% - Two or more races

7.1% - Hispanic or Latino origin

Out of the 2,945 households:

34.5% have children under the age of 18 living with them

58.3% are married couples living together

11.6% have a female householder with no husband present

24.2% are non-families

19.7% are made up of individuals

7.7% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older
