

FIBONACCI SEQUENCE QUILTS

This quilt can be made using gradation fabrics (see joysfabrics.com for fabric or check your local shops), a choice of different shades of batiks from light to dark, Stonehenge or mottled type fabrics, Ombre fabrics. We will be cutting fabric into the Fibonacci sequence and then rearranging them. The variations in shades of color give you the best outcome for this type of quilt.

Choose 7-13 different fabrics that are at least 6 inches wide. Length can be the full width of fabric (42"-44") or even fat quarter sized pieces. If you can find one piece of fabric that has a gradation of several shades of color then you need at least 1 yard.
