Double Pointed Dresden Plate Supply List David & Teresa Duwe

This class will teach you how to make double pointed Dresden plates. You may wish to make a table runner or bed runner instead of a wall quilt with your plates. The design is up to you.

- 1. Prairie Pointer tool by Susan K. Cleveland www.PiecesBeWithYou.com or local quilt shops
- 2. You will be making 64 double pointed Dresden Plate pieces (if using the Marti Michell # 8965 template) to recreate the
- quilt on the website so bring enough fabric in scraps or fabric collection to create this piece.
- 3. 1 yard background fabric
- 4. 1 yard backing fabric and batting
- 5. 1/2 yard binding fabric
- 6. wedge ruler at least 8 inches long (shortest end needs to be at least 1 3/4 inches wide) SEE TABLE BELOW
- 7. Iron and ironing board
- 8. Best Press (optional)
- 9. Flat head pins
- 10. Sewing machine with extra needles
- 11. Rotary cutter with new blade
- 12. Turn table for using template (optional)
- 13. Thread to machine or hand appliqué the plates
- 14. long ruler
