

Double Pointed Dresden Plate Supply List

This class will teach you how to make double pointed Dresden plates. You may wish to make a table runner or bed runner instead of a wall quilt with your plates. The design is up to you.

1. Prairie Pointer tool by Susan K. Cleveland [www.PiecesBeWithYou.com](http://www.PiecesBeWithYou.com) or local quilt shops
2. You will be making 64 double pointed Dresden Plate pieces (if using the Marti Michell # 8965 template) to recreate the quilt on the website so bring enough fabric in scraps or fabric collection to create this piece.
3. 1 yard background fabric
4. 1 yard backing fabric and batting
5. 1/2 yard binding fabric
6. wedge ruler at least 8 inches long (shortest end needs to be at least 1 3/4 inches wide) **SEE TABLE BELOW**
7. Iron and ironing board
8. Best Press (optional)
9. Flat head pins
10. Sewing machine with extra needles
11. Rotary cutter with new blade
12. Turn table for using template (optional)
13. Thread to machine or hand appliqué the plates
14. long ruler
