

The DeWitt Condominiums 483 Washington Ave *Brooklyn, NY*

A joint venture between Pratt Area Community Council (PRATT) and Urban Builders Collaborative (UBC) developed The DeWitt Condominiums, located at 483 Washington Avenue in Clinton Hill, Brooklyn. Designed by Curtis + Ginsberg Architects LLC, the 25,500 s.f. seven-story building includes 16 for-sale condominiums, 7 parking spaces, private and communal open spaces, a community room and laundry facility.

Residences are mixed-income and contain a mix of onebedroom, two-bedroom and penthouse apartments. Eight units were sold at market prices ranging between \$525,000 and \$1 million. The remaining eight subsidized units were sold to households selected by lottery with combined incomes less than \$88,625 for a family of four.

The DeWitt Condominiums are notable for their highquality design and energy efficient technology, a rarity amongst mixed-income buildings that are characteristically cookie-cutter in order to minimize costs.
