NEW PARISH

Welcome to St. John Paul II Catholic Church in Kankakee!

It gives me great joy to even greet you this way. Today, July 1, 2017, we made it, the day of the foundation of our new parish. It has been a unique experience journeying with you, my dear friends, to get to this new beginning. A mixture of emotions have been surging all through my heart and soul over the past few months, and especially over the past few weeks, representing in some way the same mixed emotions that many of you have been feeling during these days of transition.

HONORING OUR ROOTS. Last weekend, many of us were saddened by the closing of our three parishes, and rightly so. There is always something sad about parting, closing, like the melancholy of finishing a book, as the final page is flipped to "The End". But the best way to honor our roots; the parishes where we used to belong, is by living out the faith and devotion that have been given to us through those parishes, and be a testimony to their living legacy that still continues in us. There is much to do about these dreams, as we build our culture as a parish. And I am grateful that these have been met with so much enthusiasm over the past months, when I have publicly presented them to our community.

THANKSGIVING. I want to take this opportunity to say thank you to so many that have been so patient and generous, and absolutely supportive of the journey that we have taken so far. Many parishioners have poured out their spiritual support on me personally as their pastor, and I send back these spiritual gifts these days with prayerful blessings. I especially thank the leadership teams of our tri-parish, who have given so much of their time and efforts to advise me, to engage in the process, to be forgiving of the bumps on the road and the shifts that needed to be made, even after decisions have been brought down. I thank them for their counsel and wisdom, and their respect of the office of their priest. Thank you very much. You have all truly blessed me with your dedication. I have also received many letters of support and thanks over the past few months, many parishioners just telling me their appreciation of the efforts that we have been putting in during this time of transition.

OUR NEW PATRON. Finally, as we begin this new chapter as St. John Paul II, I invite you to not only learn more about our new patron, but also to seek his intercession. I am sure that St. John Paul II is praying for us in a special way, together with all the community of saints. Let us continue to build our prayer life and spirituality as we open the doors of our new parish. I know that our true source of strength and blessing is our deepening love of God and one another, and so I encourage you, my dear parishioners, to take to heart the power of prayer entrusted to us as the Church of Jesus Christ in our time, here in Kankakee. 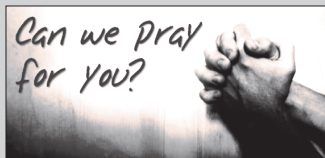

Farewell...for now...from Fr. Joel

Dear Friends,

I have come to learn in my life, moving from place to place, from one assignment and parish community to another, and especially since my retirement as I become more an itinerant minister of the gospel, going wherever there is a need from time to time, this most important lesson:

Things come and go, places come and go, people come and go. Our attachment is not to things and places, or even people. Our whole task in life is learning to let go; to learn the paradoxical lesson that it is in giving that we receive, and in dying that we come to life!

We do not make of things, places, or people, some object, some form of idolatry. Our faith does not do that. Our faith in Christ is to live in the pattern of His death and resurrection...of letting go, of dying to our false selves and our attachments so that we can discover our true selves, our true identity which is hidden with Christ in God yet to be revealed. (Col 3:3).

Christ is the ground of our being that connects us to God, one another, and all creation. The primary value of things, places, and people is that they help serve the function of connecting us to one another in Love...in God, who is our connection, the ground of our being, in whom we live and move and have our being. (Acts 17:28). They do not and are not meant to serve as an end or attachments unto themselves, but as a means to help us discover our fundamental attachment to God who connects us all in love.

That is our hope and destiny, we are created for love. Things, places, and people serve that function, they are not ends in themselves, but a means to that wonderful end which is God. They are not objects for our use, but subjects with us in the shared experience of God's cosmic universal love. We receive all things and people as God's gracious gifts of love and grace...all is grace...of which we are all stewards and co-creators with God of something wonderful and beautiful for which we are always and eternally grateful.

It is the process of life coming to be through all generations. We are in this process, as all of our ancestors before us, of letting go, of dying and rising, of giving and receiving, of coming to be. It is the Pascal Mystery we celebrate and enter into each year. We are a resurrection People, we are the People of God. It is the trajectory, direction, and pattern for all of our lives and of all creation, as St. Paul says, "Christ is all, and is in all." (Col 3:11), and "when all things are subjected to Christ then The Son will also be subjected to God who subjected all things to Christ, so that God may be all in all." (1 Cor 15:28).

We are fellow pilgrims on this journey together to the great glory of God. It is our destiny which we have been created to share through Christ, in the Spirit, with God. It has been a great privilege and blessing for me to be with you during these past four months as you begin a new future, a new parish, and a new life in Christ. I have been with you before, and will be with you again God willing, from time to time. Thank you for the great witness of your faith, your goodness, and your love. You are and will remain in my heart and prayers, my Blessings and love to each you!

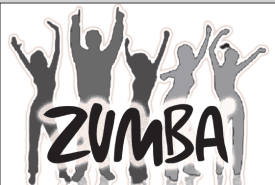
