

## KEEPING MY INNER PEACE

One of my favorite religious songs says, "The confusions around are mere reflections of what's within." How true indeed that the external realities around us are greatly affected by our inner dispositions. In this light, we begin to think that if we want to have peace with the universe and the people around us, we have to coil into ourselves and reflect: "Am I at peace deep within myself?" Whatever the answer is, it is probably good to know how to develop peace in our inner selves, and so allow me to offer some ideas.

**BE THERE WITH GOD.** During the past few months, my inner peace has been challenged greatly by many things, but one major challenge is finding time to center myself in prayer, that is, for me to simply be aware of the presence of God. In these moments, I don't have to talk to God, I just have to really be there with God. Sometimes, I describe this as "praying without any agenda." I had to make a decision that this was of utmost importance, more than the other important things that I needed to do during the transition months into our new parish. It was then more than ever that I had to be centered, focused in God.

**KNOW YOURSELF.** If I listened to every opinion that people have of me, I would go crazy. But I don't, thanks to my few years of experience in show business, television and modeling. It is impossible to please everyone, and everybody has different opinions. Most of these opinions are not really about me as a person, but about the one who has the opinion. When exposed to these opinions, it is of prime importance that you know yourself. And when I start to second guess myself, I go to very specific people that I trust, who would tell me with brutal honesty how I am doing.

**KEEP YOUR EXPECTATIONS REALISTIC.** One big disturbance to inner peace is when your expectations are unrealistic. As a pastor, for example, I get to see the bigger picture of everything about the way our parish works, for the greater infrastructures of the parish to the minute details of its operation. It is something that I learned not to expect most parishioners to understand. They have their own individual families to look after, and I am given the holy task of looking after the welfare of the parish and the spiritual wellbeing of the faithful.

**CLARIFY WHAT IS TRULY IMPORTANT.** One thing that disturbs our inner peace is when our values are upside down. A Franciscan nun once taught me to always ask this question when I start to feel disturbed: "In the end, is it really important?" or the other version that I developed for me: "If the world ends today, does it really matter much?" After trying your best, and the result is not fully as you expected it, ask that question. I realized from just simply asking this same question over and over again that many things don't matter too much in life. BUT, I also realized that it always matters to be kind and compassionate. Talking about this with Fr. Joel one evening, I told him a sample of what I would probably really want to say to someone, and he told me that as a priest, there are things that are left unsaid, and it is usually better that way. I concur. Sometimes, even what we want to say is not really that important in the first place, and so it is better to smile silently, or laugh out loud.

These days, I am honing my inner peace. I am counting blessings that have manifested themselves over the past few months. I am counting the many people who have been so generous and passionately positive about our newborn parish. I am deeply encouraged and filled with gratitude for the many encouraging letters and unsolicited prayers that have been poured out. God is good, and I am blessed. I remain in that holy space, and claim my inner peace. It is good like this, Church!

## MANTENINDO MI PAZ INTERIOR

Un canto religioso favorito dice, "Las confusiones alrededor son solo reflexiones de lo que hay en el interior" En verdad las realidades exteriores demuestran nuestra disposición interior. Bajo esta luz, iniciamos el pensar, que si queremos lograr la paz con el universo y con la gente a nuestro alrededor, tenemos que entrar en sí y reflexionar: "¿Estoy en paz conmigo mismo?" Según la respuesta, es bueno saber el cómo desarrollar la paz en sí mismos, así es que, permítanme ofrecerles algunas ideas.

**ESTAR ALLÍ CON DIOS.** En meses pasados, mi paz interior ha pasado desafíos por muchas cosas, pero el mayor desafío es el tomar tiempo para centralizarme en la oración, el estar simplemente consciente en la presencia de Dios. En esos momentos, no tengo que hablar con Dios, pero simplemente estar allí con Dios. Algunas veces, describo esto como "rezando sin agenda." Tuve que decidir que esto era de suma importancia, más que otras cosas importantes que estaba por hacer, durante los meses de transición a la nueva parroquia. Entonces más que nunca tenía que centralizarme y enfocarme en Dios.

**CONOCERSE ASÍ MISMO.** Si escuchara cada opinión de la gente hacia mí mismo, me volvería loco. Pero no lo hago, gracias a mis cuantos años de experiencia en el cine, en la televisión y modelando. Es imposible complacer a todos, y todos tienen diversas opiniones. La mayoría de las opiniones no son dirigidas a mí personalmente, pero es acerca de la que ofrece la opinión. Cuando estás expuesto a estas opiniones, es sumamente importante el conocerte a tú mismo. Y cuando no atino al conocimiento propio, entonces voy con gente conocida en quién confío, y ellos me dicen claramente cómo ando.

**MANTEN TUS EXPECTACIONES REALÍSTICAS.** Una gran perturbación a la paz interior es cuando tus expectativas no son realísticas. Como pastor, por ejemplo, yo veo el mayor panorama de cómo trabaja nuestra parroquia, desde las mayores infraestructuras de la parroquia hasta los pequeños detalles de su operación. Es algo que aprendí, el no esperar que la mayoría de los feligreses lo comprendieran. Ellos tienen que atender a sus propias familias, y yo tengo la tarea santa de ver por el bienestar de la parroquia y el bienestar espiritual de los fieles.

**CLARIFICAR LO QUE ES VERDADERAMENTE IMPORTANTE.** Una cosa que molesta nuestra paz interior es cuando nuestros valores están desordenados. Una monja Franciscana, una vez me dijo, siempre preguntarme cuando me sentía perturbado: 'Al fin de todo, ¿es en realidad importante?' o en otras palabras, me pregunto: "Si el mundo terminara hoy, ¿esto tiene sentido?" Después de esmerarte, y el resultado no es lo que esperabas, hazte esa pregunta. He visto que simplemente haciéndome esa pregunta a menudo, que muchas cosas no tienen gran importancia en la vida. PERO, he realizado que siempre lo que más importa es el ser amable y compasivo. Hablando de esto con el Padre Joel una tarde, le dije lo que yo diría probablemente a alguna persona, y él me dijo que cómo sacerdote, hay cosas donde es mejor guardar silencio. Yo estuve de acuerdo. Algunas veces es mejor sonreír en silencio, o ruidosamente.

En estos días, doy atención a mi paz interior. Estoy contando bendiciones a través de meses pasados. Contando la gente que ha sido generosa y apasionadamente positiva acerca de la recién nacida parroquia. Me siento profundamente alentado y lleno de gratitud por medio de cartas y oraciones, que sin pedirlos, he recibido en abundancia. Dios es bueno, y me siento bendecido. Permanezco en ese espacio santo, y reclamo mi paz interior. Iglesia, ¡esto es bueno!

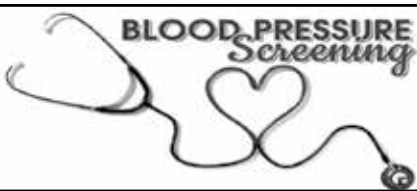

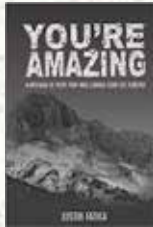
