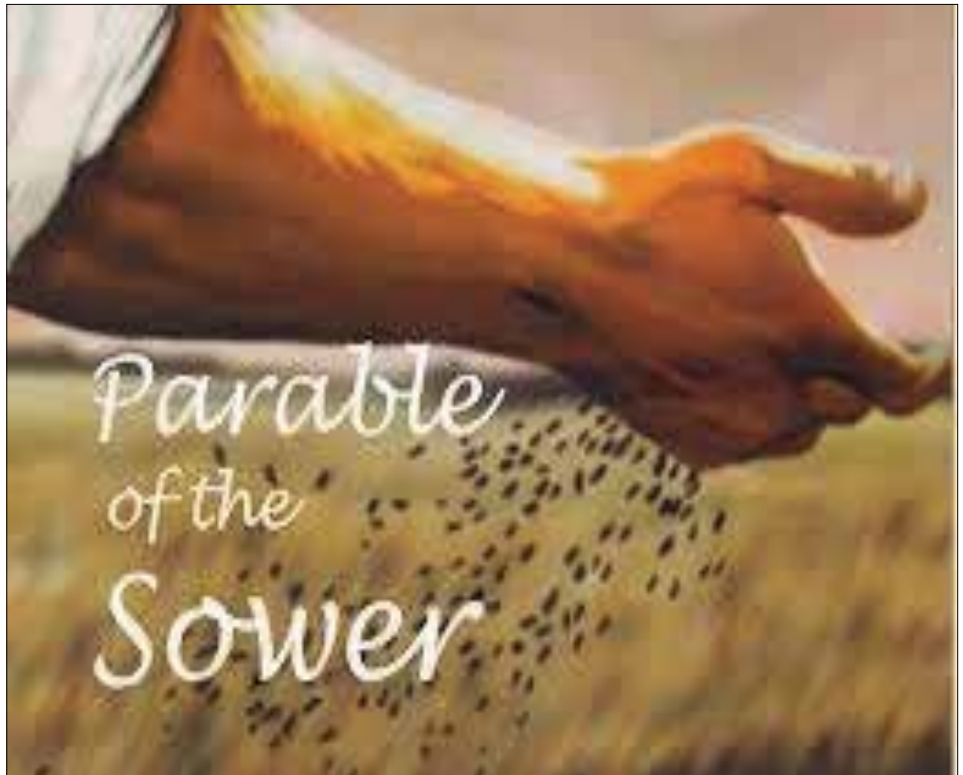

THE GATHERING: CALLING OUR YOUTH!



LA REUNION: LLAMANDO A NUESTROS JOVENES!

With the vision to be a church for the young Catholics, St. John Paul II Parish is being intentional about looking for ways to collaborate with the youth. On the first Sunday of the Gathering, after the 5:00 PM Sunday Mass, I had a chance to dream with the youth about the future. The intention was not to build a youth group, but to provide a place where they can feel at home in their parish, invite their friends, and have a worthwhile time playing and praying, learning and teaching, sharing and building community among them. There were over 20 youth there, and I am confident that the number will continue to grow.

These days, our youth, which we have known in recent years as the Hearts of Hope, will be doing a lot of good work serving the Pembroke community. This annual summer outreach has born many fruits in that part of the county, and I am pleased to see that there are always a lot of youth who participate. There are usually more than fifty young Catholics who participate every year, and the amount of support is also equally encouraging. I have seen our youth transform empty lots into gardens. I have seen them build sheds, playgrounds, ramps for the disabled, and take care of the elderly in one of the assisted living facilities there. In the evening, there were some sharing groups and prayer sessions that lifted up the spirits of many who took part. Needless to say, our young parishioners have so much to show us and teach us about being a church for the poor. Thank you Ken and Michelle Barrie for their lifelong commitment to our youth ministry here in Kankakee.

I want to take this opportunity to also encourage our youth to invite more and to welcome more into their community. With Alex Quezada being on our staff, I believe it is a ripe time to focus on the integration of our Catholic Youth. I know that we have many Hispanic Youth who are looking to be more involved in worthwhile events. I have seen an increase in participation of our Latino Youth in matters of the entire parish, but I know that there are many others who are just waiting to be invited and called. Well, this is your Fr. Sunny, inviting and calling. Come and see us at The Gathering on Sunday evenings.

In January of 1995, Pope John Paul II saw a record breaking attendance to the 10th World Youth Day in Manila. There were over four million who attended from all over the world. In the concelebration mass for that year's World Youth Day, he addressed the young people:

"Parents and older people sometimes feel that they *have lost contact with you, and they are upset, just as Mary and Joseph felt anguish when they realized that Jesus had stayed behind in Jerusalem. I am asking you to build bridges of dialogue and communication with your parents. No splendid isolation! Communication! Love! Be a healthy influence on society to help to break down the barriers, which have been raised between generations! No barriers! No barriers! Communion between generations, between parents and sons and daughters. Communion!"*

I would like to re-echo our patron's sentiments now. I call you forth to communion, to build community, to not be isolated but to be engaged, to be part of the Church. As a youth, I was involved in the Church and I know that many of my gifts have been shared then, and that is why I am who I am today. Know that your Church family cares very much for you, we would like to invest every effort to have you be part of the life of our parish. I pray that you will respond joyfully and generously to this call. We need you, and we love you. It is a beautiful thing to be part of the Church! God bless our youth!

Con la visión de ser una iglesia para los Católicos, la Iglesia de San Juan Pablo II tendrá la intención de buscar maneras de colaborar con los jóvenes. En el primer Domingo de la Reunión, después de la misa de las 5:00PM, tuve oportunidad de soñar con los jóvenes del futuro. La intención no fue de formar un grupo juvenil, sino proveer un lugar donde se pueden sentir en casa en su parroquia, invitar a sus amigos y tener un tiempo que valga la pena jugando y rezando, aprendiendo y enseñando, compartiendo y construyendo comunidad entre ellos. Había más de 20 jóvenes allí y confío en que el número aumentará.

Estos días, nuestros jóvenes, los cuales hemos conocido como Hearts of Hope (Corazones de Esperanza) han hecho mucho trabajo sirviendo a la comunidad de Pembroke. De este programa anual de verano han nacido muchos frutos en esa parte del condado y estoy muy complacido ver que siempre hay muchos jóvenes que participan. Usualmente hay más de cincuenta jóvenes Católicos que se reúnen cada año y la cantidad de apoyo que brindan es igual de alentador. He visto a nuestros jóvenes transformar espacios vacíos en jardines. Los he visto construir pequeños almacenes, lugares para jugar, rampas para los incapacitados también cuidaron de las personas mayores en uno de los asilos. Por la tarde, había grupos donde compartían sus experiencias, sesiones de oraciones que les levantan el espíritu a los que toman parte. No necesitamos decir, nuestros jóvenes feligreses tienen tanto que enseñarnos en ser una iglesia para los pobres. Gracias Ken y Michelle Barrie por su gran compromiso para con nuestro ministerio de jóvenes aquí en Kankakee.

Quiero tomar esta oportunidad de animar a nuestros jóvenes a invitar a más y darles la bienvenida a su comunidad. Con Alex Quezada en nuestra oficina, creo que es bueno enfocarnos en la integración de nuestros Jóvenes Católicos. Sé que tenemos varios Jóvenes Hispanos que están buscando involucrarse más en eventos que valen la pena. He visto un incremento de participación de nuestros Jóvenes Latinos en toda la parroquia, pero sé que hay otros que solo están esperando ser invitados y llamados. Bueno este es su pastor, Padre Sunny invitando y llamando. Vengan a vernos en la Reunión los Domingos por la tarde.

En Enero de 1995, el Papa San Juan Pablo II miro una asistencia que rompió record en el Décimo Día Mundial de Jóvenes en Manila. Había más de cuatro millones que asistieron de todo el mundo. En la misa de concelebración de ese año del Día Mundial de Jóvenes, se dirigió a los jóvenes:

"Padres y personas mayores a veces sienten que han perdido contacto con ustedes, y están tristes, así como María y José se sintieron angustiados cuando se dieron cuenta que Jesús se tenía que quedar atrás en Jerusalén. Les estoy pidiendo que construyan puentes de dialogo y comunicación con sus padres. No insolución espléndida! Comunicación! Amor! Sean una influencia sana en la sociedad para ayudar a romper las barreras, que han sido creadas entre generaciones! No barreras! No barreras! Comunicación entre generaciones, entre padres e hijos. Comunicación."

Ahora me gustaría hacer eco en los sentimientos de nuestro patrón. Les llamo a la comunión, a construir comunidad, no a estar insolados sino a tomar parte de la Iglesia. Cuando joven, estube envuelto en la Iglesia y se que muchos de mis dones fueron entonces compartidos, y por eso soy quien soy el día de hoy. Ahora que tu familia de la Iglesia se preocupa tanto por ti, nos gustaría invertir cada esfuerzo por que seas parte de la vida de nuestra parroquia. Rezo porque contestes con alegría y generosidad a este llamado. Te necesitamos, te queremos. Es una cosa hermosa ser parte de la Iglesia! Dios bendiga a nuestros Jóvenes!

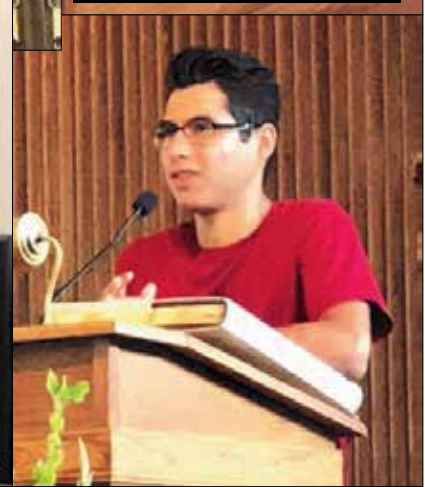

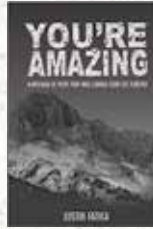
