

## **PCSA RANGE RULES FOR ALL RANGES**

- 1. SAFTY FIRST! The safe handling of firearms will be the responsibility of everyone on the range. At all times be cautious and considerate of others on the range.**
- 2. Your membership gives range privileges to your spouse and children under your guardianship less than 19 years of age. All children under 19 years of age must be in direct control and supervision of an adult member. Those over 19 must have their own membership. Your membership card and key must be with you when you are on the range, and presented with picture identification upon request.**
- 3. Guests must be with a member, fill out the liability form, and notify the PCSA secretary well prior to using the range. At the discretion of the board of directors, failure to register with the secretary and fill out liability form will cause the loss of membership of the host member. Guests will be allowed one free visit; thereafter a \$10.00 fee will be charged. The key to the range must be with you and cannot be loaned to anyone. The gate must be locked behind you upon entering or leaving the range. The hot range flag must be run up by the first person on the range, and taken down by the last person to leave. NO camping, open fires or hunting is permitted on this facility. All pets must remain in your vehicle. Park in designated areas. Drive only on designated routes. No activities are to impact the side berms. Range hours are from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday - Saturday April 1<sup>st</sup> - September 30<sup>th</sup>; 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday - Saturday October 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>; 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM Sundays year long.**
- 4. Hearing and eye protection must be worn when on the firing line. The target benches will constitute the firing line on all ranges, and all shooting must be done from behind the benches. No one is allowed forward of the firing line until all actions are open and all firearms on that particular range are unloaded. Unloaded means there are no cartridges in the chambers or magazines of the firearms on that range. No handling of firearms during ceasefire. All firearms are to remain unloaded until everyone is back behind the firing line before resuming firing.**
- 5. If no Range officer is present, anyone desiring to change targets must notify the shooters on that firing line, and all agree to a "cease fire" before going forward of the firing line. The red safety flag must be displayed at the firing line until all shooters are behind the firing line. No one is to go behind the dirt back stop or behind the target frames. All firearms are to remain unloaded as per rule number 4 until it is agreed firing can resume. All guns are to remain unloaded until on the firing line.**
- 6. Only paper targets are to be used on target frames, and are to be attached well clear of the frames and support posts to prevent damage to them. All bullets are to impact well within the dirt backstops behind the target frames, support posts, or berms. Metal targets must be placed to the side of target frames and slightly in front of target frames so bullets impact within the target berms. All targets, other than paper, must be approved by the PCSA BOARD. Do not shoot at rocks, trees, shrubs, bottles, or cans. Before leaving remove your paper targets and trash, and police your brass.**

**This includes rim fire brass. Place brass you do not want in the designated containers. No dumping of any kind.**

- 7. No armor piecing, tracer, flare, steel core, or steel jacketed ammunition is allowed. In addition, exploding targets and shot shells are prohibited.**
- 8. No alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed on this facility. Anyone violating this rule will be reported to law enforcement. Use caution when smoking, and use designated butt cans.**
- 9. Any exceptions to these rules or any special use of the range must be approved by the PCSA board of directors.**
- 10. At the discretion of the PCSA Board, any violation of these rules will result in liability for damages and loss of membership.**

**If this is a family membership, both spouses must sign.**
