Georgia Women's Golf Association Grant program was first presented in 2008. The funds for these donations come from our memberships' tax-deductible contributions to the Grant categories consisting of Par, Birdie, Eagle, and Albatross. Our purpose is to help an organization with funds to develop, promote, maintain and protect the best interests of the game of golf among amateur female golfers throughout the State of Georgia. An organization that promotes girls and/or women golf programs is eligible to apply for one of the minimum \$500.00/maximum \$1000.00 Grants. Funds may be used for equipment, team/group uniforms, team/group entry fees, and teaching aids. To date we have proudly contributed to over thirty-six girls' school golf programs.

In 2016, GWGA awarded Grant Funds to 8 school programs for 'girls' golf: Ashworth Middle School, Carrollton Golf, Calhoun High School, Cedartown High School, Gordon Central School, Veterans High School and Woodward Academy. A total of \$6,800 was awarded with \$850 presented to each middle school and high school program. These funds are generally used to pay for the players' clothing, golf balls, bags, and supplies, travel expenses, and improvement of school practice areas for the players.

The Grant Application must be filled out and returned to the GWGA Board of Directors by the Grant Application due date of **June 15, 2017**. Address and contact information is on the last page of the Grant Application.

One page of a supporting document may be attached to the Grant Application.

Each section and question or area will be rated by the Board of Directors based on the Grant purpose using the following scale:

- 4—Excellent/exceeds requirements**
- 3—Very good**
- 2—Good**
- 1—Poor**
- 0—Did not address**

The organization(s) to be awarded Grant Funds will be determined at the GWGA Board Meeting in July 2017. The "Primary Application Contact" will be informed after the meeting by a Board Member by email. Grant Funds will be distributed after October 1, 2017. The Grant winners will be announced at the Champions Banquet in July 2017. Picture(s) of the awarding of the Grant Funds will appear on the GWGA website.
