If the address on the driver's license is NOT the buyer's current residential address, the Federal Government requires a supplemental document be provided. This document must be a valid, **government-issued** document (state, local, or federal) showing the buyer's **name and current residential address**. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- A change of address card issued by the CA DMV (face-to-face)
- A current vehicle registration issued by the CA DMV
- A current property tax bill from your county
- A utility bill if your utility is a government entity (i.e. your city or county)
- A recent tax document received from the federal, state, or local government (i.e. a tax document generated by and received from the IRS or FTB)
