- ~ Stimulates the body's natural production of hormones, blocks pain receptor sensitivity, and helps alleviate pain and inflammation

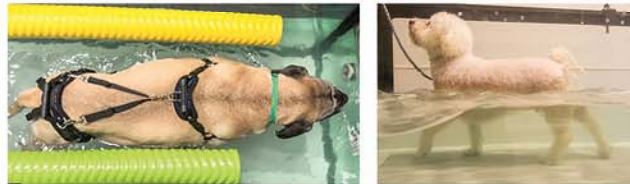
